



Dear Parents,

At Leasowes we work extremely hard with parents to build open and honest communication between school and home. We do this through senior leaders carrying out gate duty every morning, our website, regular newsletters, Parents' Evenings, Parent Forum, workshops, Family Learning and School Reports. We also provide a questionnaire for parents during the spring Parents' Evening. These questionnaires are analysed and results are shared with all stakeholders.

There are key points throughout the year when we share information about the progress and attainment of your child. This is normally completed through Parents Evening and the thorough end of year school report. However, we are always trying to improve. After receiving feedback from parents, we have decided to trial a progress report. The progress report is in addition to Parents' Evenings and the full end of year written report. This report is intended to give you a 'snapshot' of attendance, attainment, progress and effort. It is not intended to be in any more detail as this is carried out at other times. The EYFS progress report will be slightly different; highlighting the areas of learning that children need to achieve to reach what is known as 'a good level of development'.

With the addition of the progress report, information will now be shared at the following times throughout the year:

- Autumn 1 – Parents' Evening
- Autumn 2 – Progress Report (new)
- Spring 1 – Parents' Evening (this has changed from Spring 2 to Spring 1)
- Spring 2 – Progress Report (new)
- Summer – Full written end of year report

I hope that you will find the progress reports useful and help to keep you informed about your child.
