2. What is Sports Premium Funding?

In 2013 the government announced spending of £150 million per year to be used in schools throughout the UK, specifically to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools. Schools are free to spend the funding in whatever area of PE and sport that they feel needs to be improved upon. Examples can range from buying in coaches to purchasing new equipment.

*The Government has recently announced that for 2017-18 the budget will be increased. With this change, we estimate our budget for the year to be £19,690. This Strategy Statement has been written to this figure, with the money being spent as and when it is received.

3. Physical Education and Sport at Leasowes

At Leasowes we will use the money effectively in order to implement a PE programme which will ensure that all pupils leaving our school are physically literate and have the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and a lifelong love of physical activity and sport. All pupils at Leasowes take part in two structured PE lessons per week, one of which is delivered by a specialist PE teacher which enables us to deliver high quality PE following the National Curriculum. This year we plan to use the additional funding to:

- Engage all our pupils in regular physical activity, kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
- Provide a broader range of sports and activities to all our pupils all year round, led by qualified PE teachers within and outside of the curriculum
- Educate the children in how to manage their fitness and wellbeing
- Continue to increase the opportunities for pupils to participate in competitive sport
- Gain recognition as a PE school of Excellence
- Provide CPD for our teachers

After careful consideration by the Governing Body it was decided that the money is to be used as outlined below:

- Purchase new equipment where needed
- Pay for affiliation, entry fees and certificates
- Develop outdoor facilities in order to allow sporting activities all year round and to encourage sports at play and lunchtime
- Pay for a part time qualified specialist PE support assistant to work alongside and be managed by the PE specialist
- Fund a 'Fitness and wellbeing' programme
- Apply for the 'afPE' Quality Mark
- Fund our PE specialist to achieve the Level 5 PE Qualification and a swimming qualification

Action	Review of Impact	Cost
Purchase of Astro Turf	Key Stage One pupils now have an area to play ball games during playtimes, freeing up an area on the playground for other physical activities. The Astro Turf is also used during clubs run voluntarily by the staff after school, such as cricket, football and multi skills activities.	£9500
Affiliation Fees	Leasowes children accessed a wide variety of competition last year, with us entering up to three teams in some events. As a result we gained the 'Gold School Games Mark'.	£80
Purchase of Outdoor Equipment	Outdoor equipment was purchased, not only to enhance the provision of PE lessons, but to also be used when 'zoning' the playground during playtimes. During this time, activities such as football, circus skills, skipping, golf and cheerleading were funded using this money.	£1100
Cricket Coaching	Year Five pupils accessed quality cricket teaching run by a qualified cricket coach. Not only did this enhance the skills of the children, but also provided CPD for the class teachers involved.	£500
