Dear Parents,

Leasowes does not allow children to bring mobile phones into school, therefore please make sure that they stay at home. We are aware that on occasions there may be a genuine reason where a mobile phone may be necessary for certain situations. If this is the case then permission must be requested by a parent. If you feel your child needs a mobile phone please complete the form below requesting permission and return to the school office. Children who are granted permission will bring their mobile phone up to the office at the start of the day to be stored safely and will collect it at the end of the day. Any child that has a mobile phone on them without permission, parents will be contacted and an adult will need to collect it from the office.

As always safeguarding is our utmost priority and we need to keep children and staff of the school safe. We fully appreciate the support from parents and these actions will quickly allow school to focus back on the education of your child. We will continue to teach children about the appropriate use of mobile phones to prepare them for secondary school and support them in navigating the digital world.
