Nursery Harvest Assembly

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to invite you into school to help celebrate Harvest with the children. The Nursery Harvest Assembly is in the KS1 school hall on Wednesday the 11th of October at 10.15 a.m. and will last approximately half an hour (no more than two parents/guests per child please).

All children are invited to attend this celebration. If your child is not normally with us on a Wednesday morning and they would like to join us for the Harvest Assembly, please drop them off at the nursery front entrance at 10.05 a.m. before making your way to the school hall. Please collect them from the same entrance on your way out.

After the event, <u>all</u> children will be taken back to the nursery classroom. Could we politely request that you wait in the hall until all the children have left before leaving yourself and that you refrain from taking your child home directly from the hall. This makes it very difficult for the staff to keep track of the children and your child will need to be signed out of the setting before they leave.

If your child normally leaves nursery at 11.45 a.m. or 12.15 p.m. on a Wednesday and you would like to take them home with you straight after the Harvest celebrations, please collect them from the Nursery front entrance on your way out.
