- ☐ Locate the 4 countries of the United Kingdom and their capital cities on a map.
- ☐ To develop a sense of place of each capital city, use a range of maps to locate the key human and physical features (places and landmarks) of Edinburgh, Cardiff and Belfast.
- ☐ There are borders that separate different parts of the world and different countries.
- ☐ A continent is a land mass and an ocean is a large body of water.
- ☐ Name and locate the seven continents: Oceania, Europe, Antarctica, South America, North America, Africa and Asia.
- ☐ The majority (71%) of the world's surface is covered by water.
- ☐ Name and locate the five oceans: The Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Southern and Arctic.
- ☐ The climate differs depending on the continent.
- ☐ The equator is the hottest part of the earth: this is due to the earth's orbit around the sun.
