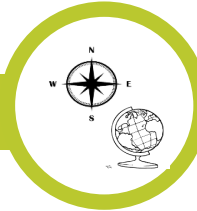

A study of significant explorers, transport and places around the world.



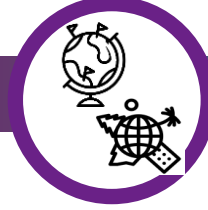

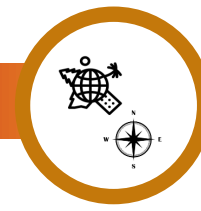

Geographical Regions of the UK



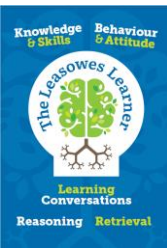
Name and locate the counties and cities of the UK.

Countries of the World and Europe



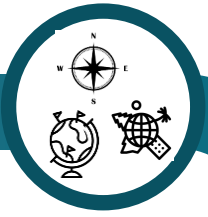
Locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on Europe (including Russia).

An in-depth study of a region within Europe. Mountains and volcanoes.

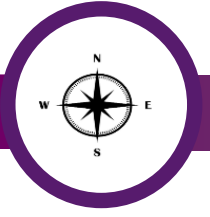
Stratford-upon-Avon
