Dear Parents,

**Year 6 Residential – Condover Hall 3<sup>rd</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> November 2025**

As you may be aware, the children in Year 6 are provided with the opportunity of completing a residential week, which again for this year will be held at Condover Hall, located just outside Shrewsbury. This residential will take place this year during the first week back after the Autumn Half term, with the children leaving on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November and arriving back on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> November. We like to complete the residential at the beginning of your child's year in Year 6 to build a team ethic that will last for the rest of the children's final year at Leasowes. Additionally, we have planned the visit to Condover Hall as a SESAT residential, with the Year 6 children of Barnfields also joining us. This will provide the children with the chance to interact with others who may well become their peers at Walton High School and begin to build new relationships.

We feel that this residential provides the children with an invaluable extension to the many opportunities and experiences on offer within school to meet the needs of the Outdoor Education Curriculum. During the week the children will take part in many exciting activities, from wall climbing and abseiling to high wires and archery. These, as well as others, are new experiences that the children may never have the opportunity to take part in again.

At Leasowes, we encourage all children to attend. The children will work in groups throughout the week, where they will learn to work together as effective teams, develop independence and confidence; understanding the need to challenge themselves to progress further. Additionally, the children will spend a week away from home, which in itself helps to build resilience.

As I am sure you are aware, we are seeing a dramatic rise in the cost of living. With transport included, the cost of taking each child to Condover Hall will be **£351** this year. However, as we value the visit so much it has been agreed that school will heavily subsidise this, bringing the cost down to **£295** per child. This payment will cover transport; all activities (up to five per day); four night's accommodation; breakfast, lunch and dinner each day plus comprehensive insurance.

Please complete the consent form attached by **Thursday 19th December 2024** and return to school. A deposit of **£50** will need to be paid by **Friday 31st January 2025**. **This will be followed by a payment of £125 by Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2025** with the balance of **£120** to be paid by **Friday 11th July 2025**. Payments may be made via SchoolMoney. Payments can be made at any point but the stated amounts must be paid by the dates specified. The whole balance can be paid in full by 31<sup>st</sup> January if you prefer that option.
