I know about and recognise the signs of Summer.

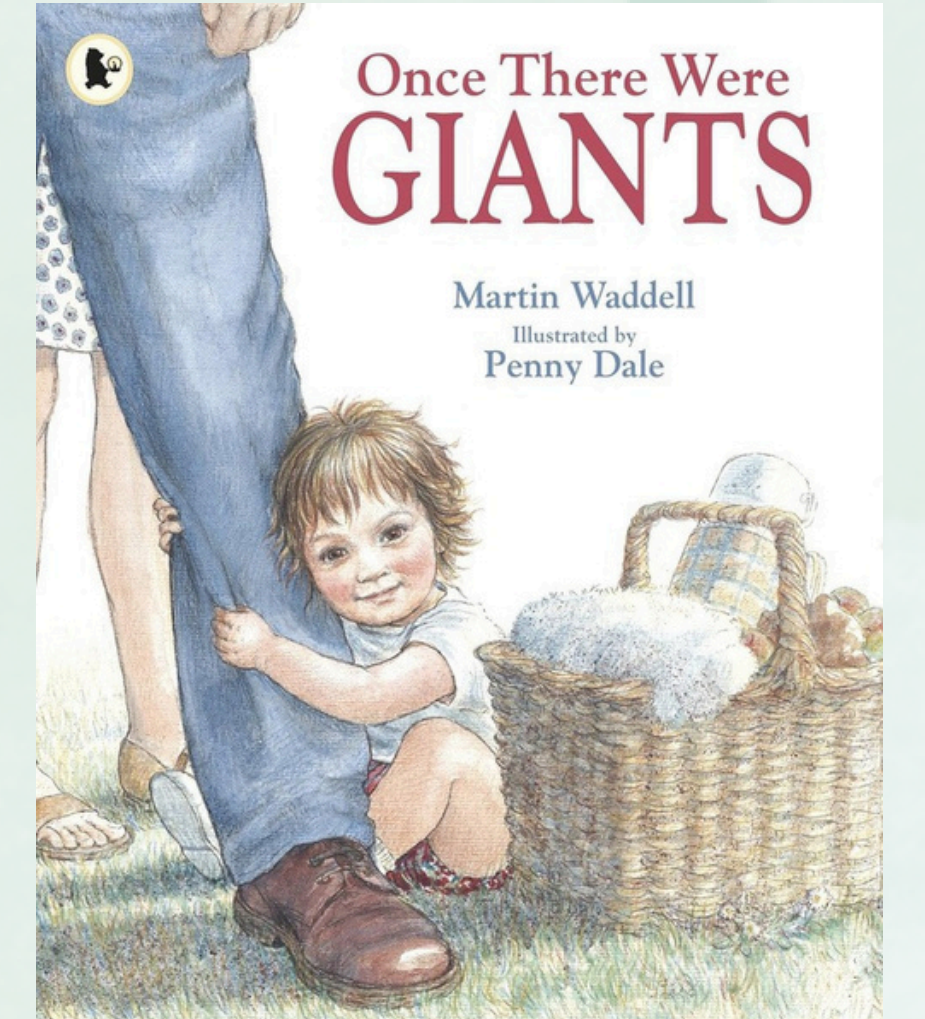
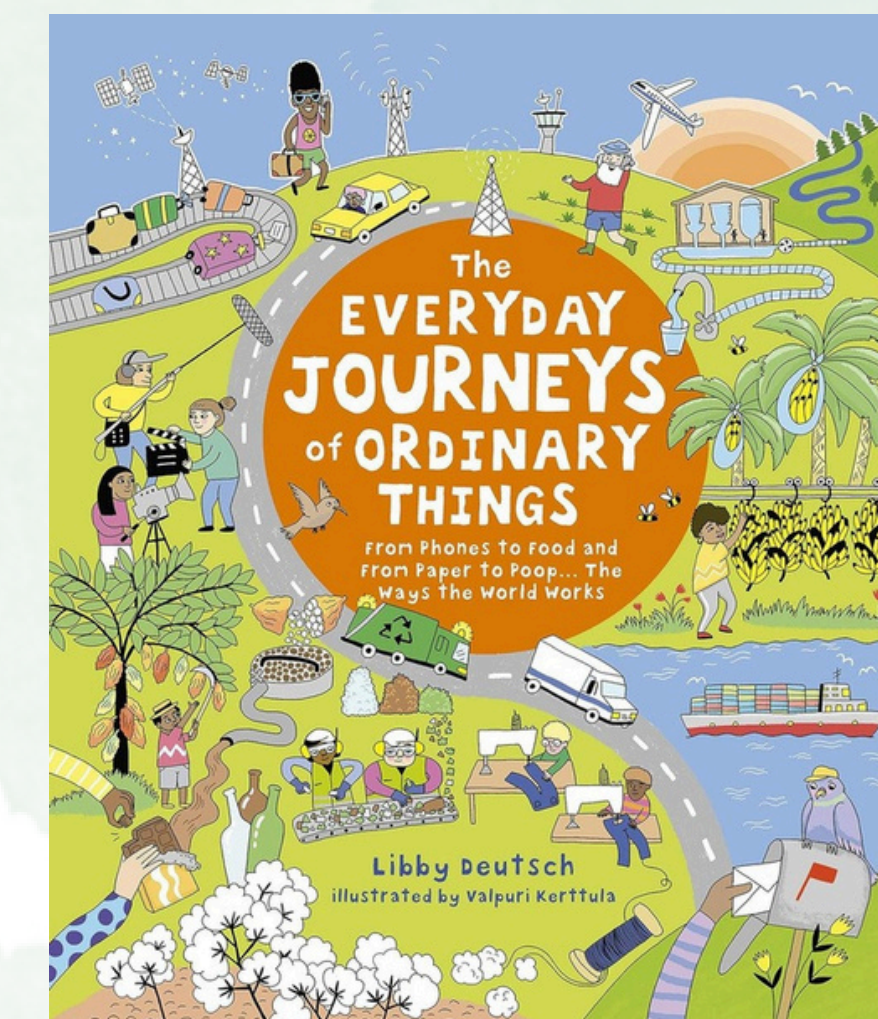
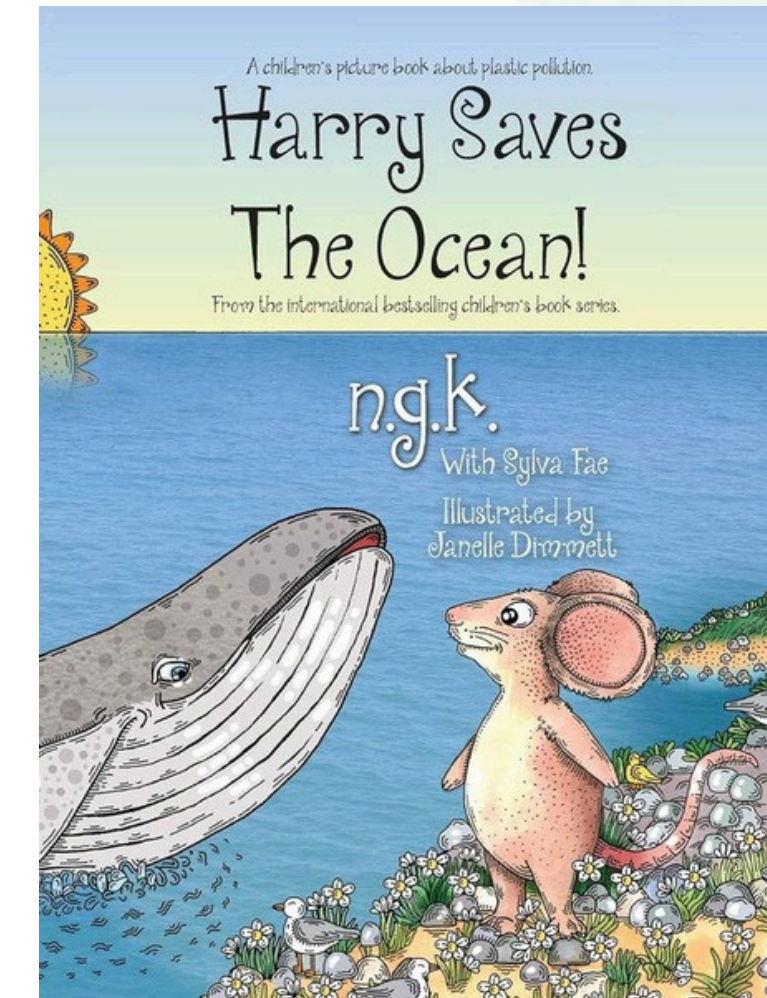
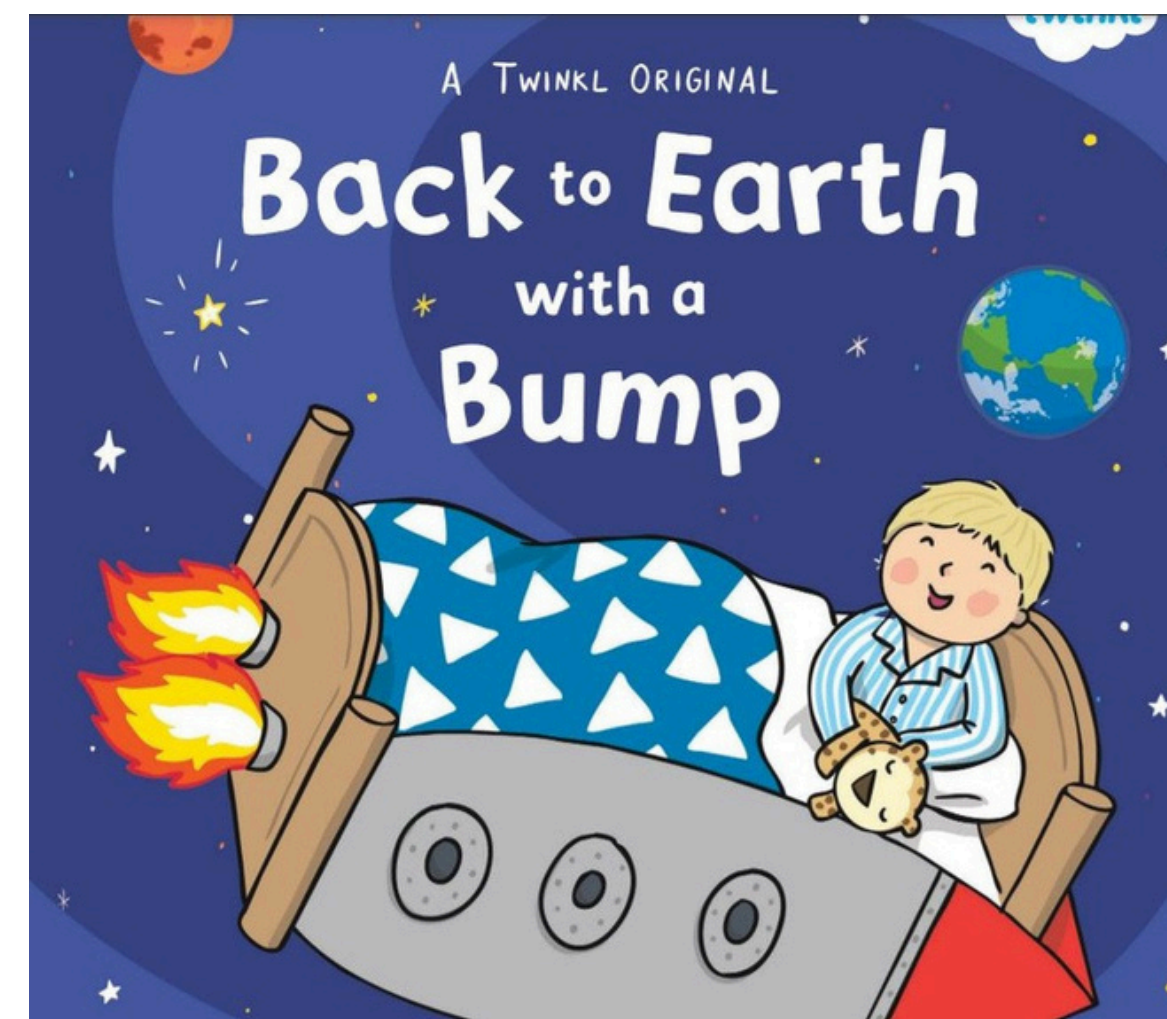
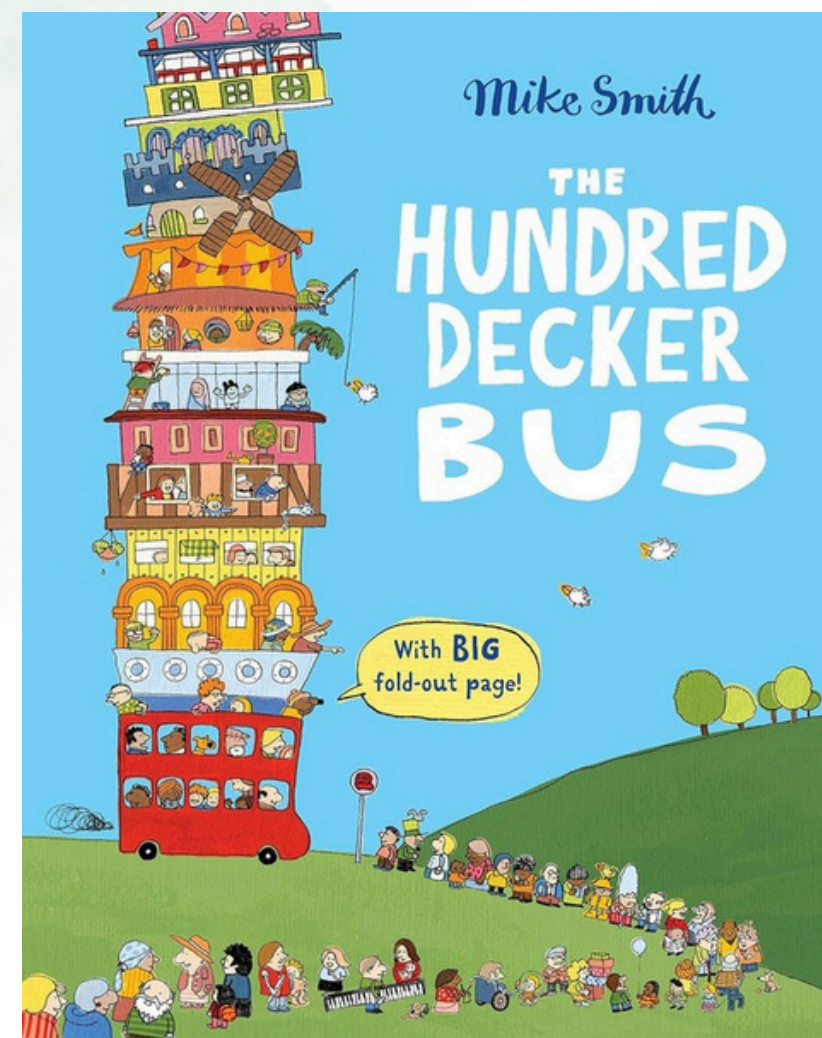
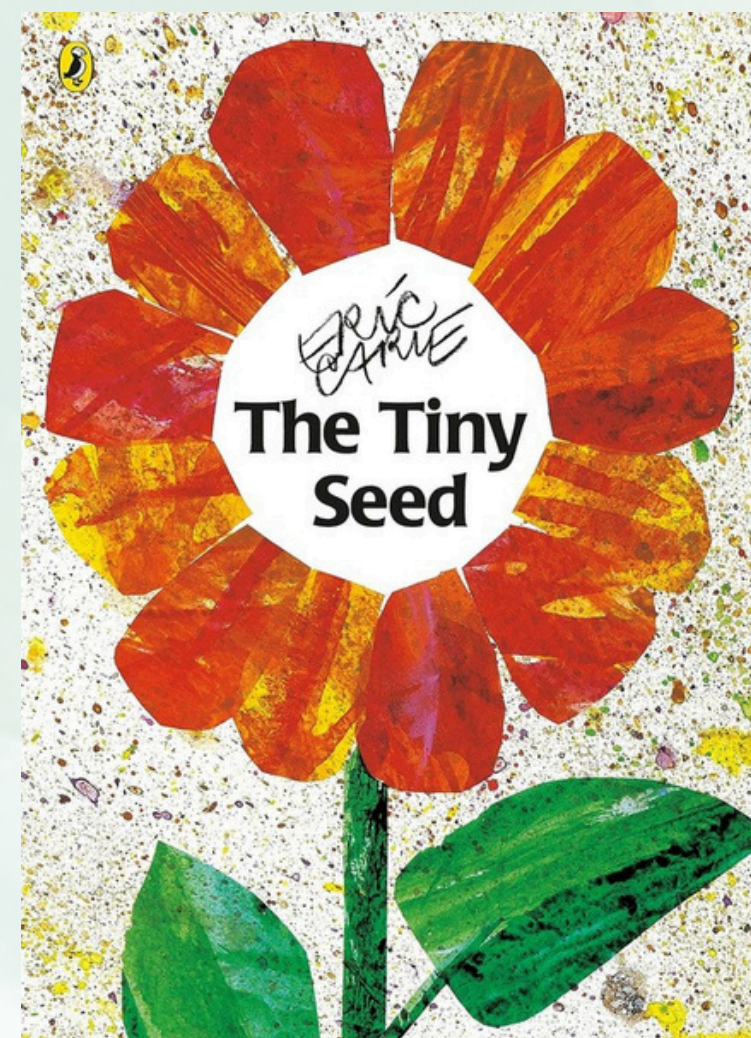
I know how to care for seeds and will help look after the outdoor environment.
