- Our school and **every house** in our country has an **address** and a **postcode**.
- An address contains the street name, building/house number, town/city and the postcode.
- An **aerial image** is a photograph taken from **above**.
- Maps** contain **symbols** which show important human and physical features.
- Human features were **created** by humans e.g. houses and roads.
- Physical features are **naturally** occurring e.g. hills, lakes and trees.
- The human and physical features **surrounding** Leasowes and Weeping Cross **impact** the communities that live there e.g. houses, shops, doctors, library and school.
- Key **physical features** of the U.K include, rivers, valleys, sea, mountains, hills, forests, cliffs and beaches.
- Key **human features** of the U.K. include villages, towns, cities, harbours, factories, offices, farms, ports, houses and shops.

- The **United Kingdom** is made up of **4 countries**, England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
- We live in a **town** called **Stafford** which is in England.
- In each country there are villages, towns and cities. The **capital city of England is London**.
- The capital city of **Scotland is Edinburgh**. The capital city of **Wales is Cardiff**. The capital city of **Northern Ireland is Belfast**.
- The **seas** that surround the United Kingdom are the **North Sea, the Irish Sea, the Atlantic Ocean and the English Channel**.
