

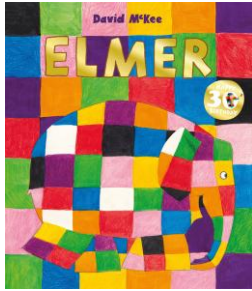

This week we have been reading 'Little Red Riding Hood'. The children have enjoyed retelling the story using our small world characters. This has helped them with remembering the sequence of events in the story and the different characters. We also discussed 'stranger danger' and how Little Red Riding Hood was told not to talk to anyone on her way to Grandma's house. We talked about safe and unsafe strangers then played out different scenarios of how the children may meet a stranger. The children were really good at saying 'no' to people they don't know and going to tell a grown up they trust. The children have also been engaged in other activities based on this story, they have made 'Wanted' wolf posters, fed the wolf an alternative to Grandma and made a fruit basket to make Grandma feel better.
