Dear Parents,

We are delighted to share details of the upcoming Leasowes Fundraising Day on **Thursday 26th March**. This is a special event designed not only to raise money for important causes but also to deepen the children's understanding of global citizenship, empathy and the experiences of others around the world.

This will be the second Leasowes Fundraising Day, building on the success and enthusiasm of the last event. Once again, the Rights Ambassadors in school have taken the lead in planning the day. They have thoughtfully selected four charities that reflect our school values of respect, courage, enjoyment, collaboration, love and aspiration whilst working towards a range of different Global Goals:

- WaterAid
- Save the Children
- Book Aid International
- Mary's Meals



These charities support children's rights across the globe - rights such as access to clean water (Article 24), the right to education (Article 28) and the right to nutritious food and a safe environment (Articles 27 and 6). By engaging with these causes, we learn that not all children share the same opportunities and that they have the power to make a positive difference.

Throughout the morning, all children (including nursery) will have the opportunity to visit a variety of stalls and activities that have been designed and selected by the Rights Ambassadors. These include a lucky book dip, a penalty shoot-out and several other fundraising activities.

Key information for the day:

- Children are invited to take part in a non-uniform day on **Thursday 26th March** and we kindly request a £1 donation for this.
- We ask that children bring only 20p, 50p or £1 coins to spend during the fundraising activities as this will enable our Rights Ambassadors and Junior Leadership Team to manage the money safely and efficiently.
