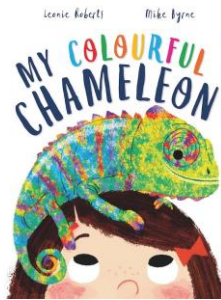

Snapshots of this Week's Learning and Activities



This week, we have been reading 'The Selfish Crocodile'. We discussed what the word 'selfish' means and why the crocodile in the story wasn't being kind to others. The crocodile gets a painful crack in its tooth and this helped us explore the importance of looking after our teeth and keeping our mouths healthy. The children shared ideas about good oral hygiene and why caring for our teeth is important. On Thursday, we celebrated World Book Day. We started the day with a story from Mrs Widdett, our mystery reader, and then we shared the children's 'Book in a Bag'.

Other Information

If you receive 30-hour free funding for your child, please remember to re-validate your eligibility with HMRC every three months. You can do this up to 28 days before your eligibility runs out and as soon as you receive a reminder from HMRC. Failure to do this could result in your eligibility lapsing and should this happen, you would then be responsible for settling any unpaid nursery fees.
