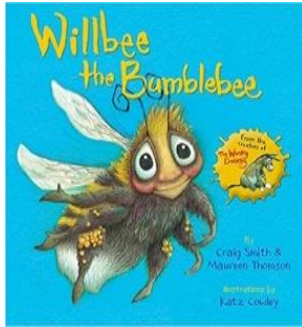

This week we have been reading 'My Colourful Chameleon'. The children have enjoyed a range of activities linked to the book such as colour sorting where we grouped objects by their colour. We have also watched our class chameleon changing colour and explored the word 'camouflage'. We have learnt that animals need to change colour to help keep them safe. On Wednesday, we took our chameleon into the woodland area to play a game of hide and seek. We had to look carefully to spot where the chameleon was hiding as he had camouflaged himself amongst the leaves and trees.
