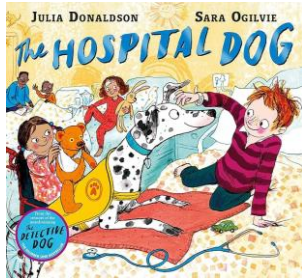

Other Information

If you receive 30-hour free funding for your child, please remember to re-validate your eligibility with HMRC every three months. You can do this up to 28 days before your eligibility runs out and as soon as you receive a reminder from HMRC. **Please note, you need to do this right up until your child leaves Nursery to ensure your full entitlement to free funding is paid until your child starts school.**
